### Den Chief Job Description

All boys who plan to be Den Chiefs in order to successfully meet the leadership requirements for Life rank must fulfill the following:

1. Talk with your den leader at least once a week outside of the den meetings. Get into the habit of calling the den leader on a weekly basis to organize and review their plans for the den meeting in the upcoming week.
2. Prepare a list of all of the boys in your den with names, addresses and phone numbers. Take the time to learn all of their names plus something about each Cub Scout. Be prepared to discuss these with the den chief advisor for Troop 89 after the first month. Some telephone calls during the week will be necessary.
3. Teach the den a skit, craft, magic trick, etc each month (four to six total)
4. Give the den chief advisor for Troop 89 the telephone number of your den leader. Your advisor will call the leader to make sure they are aware of our plans and ask if they have any questions.
5. Be sure to attend and participate with your den at all pack meetings during your six months.
6. Be sure you attend the pack Blue and Gold Banquet with your den if there is one during your tenure as den chief.
7. Have your den leader read this document and give them a copy when you first begin. This will be a "contract" between you and your den leader. At the end of your six months we will ask your den leader to complete this contract to verify that you have fulfilled your obligations.
